sl.no	Theme	Special tips
1	Myself About Me	<p>Ask the child to colour the picture that is like him/her</p> <p>Ask the child to introduce about themselves</p> <p>With their name, age.</p> <p>Encourage them to speak about themselves in few sentences.</p> <p>Rhymes – lam special lam special, Look at me..</p>
2	My body parts My body moves Keeping my body clean	<p>Ask the child to point to different parts of the body.</p> <p>Play a game where you ask the child to do actions sit, stand, raise hand, clap, jump, hop, throw, run, punch, kick etc upon your instructions.</p> <p>Talk about cleanliness to keep our body clean.</p> <p>Rhymes – chubby cheeks, Head shoulder knees, after a bath ,</p>
3	I need food to... Feelings	<p>Ask child about the foods that he/she likes to eat\drink.</p> <p>Importance of eating on time and good eating habits.</p> <p>Explain why food should not be wasted.</p> <p>Talk about right eating habits.</p> <p>Rhymes – pat a cake , hot cross bun</p> <p>Speak about the different feelings using smileys such as happy, sad, angry, scared. Mimic the feeling and ask the child to identify</p> <p>Rhyme – are you sleeping, jhonny jhonny...</p>

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4	My family My house Safety at home	<p>Ask the child to paste the photographs of their family members.</p> <p>Ask the child to name the members of his/her family.</p> <p>Rhymes – Mummy and daddy, Jack and jill.</p> <p>Let the child name different room in a house. What are things we find in each room.</p> <p>Explain children importance of safety. What are the things they should not do at home.</p> <p><i>(like touching switch board/wires, locking the door, touching the fire, running on the stairs, using scissors, playing with match stick, jumping of sofa/chair, leaning from the balcony, going alone on terrace, playing ba;; inside, touching medicines)</i></p>
5	My school Safety in school	<p>Ask the child to name his/her school.</p> <p>Ask him how he/she comes to school.</p> <p>Let the child name the things he/she see in school</p> <p>Explain safety at playground while playing.</p> <p>Rhymes – Marry had a little,</p>
6	Community helpers Places around us	<p>Ask the child to name different people who help us in our daily life.</p> <p>Have a fancy dress competition.</p> <p>Conduct role play and ask each child to be a community helper and how they help.</p> <p>Rhymes – Miss polly has a dolly, Barber barber.</p>

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7.	Animals	<p>Ask the child about to name few animals that he has seen.</p> <p>Animals from jungles, animals that live around us. Include birds, insects and small animals too.</p> <p>Speak about kindness to all living things.</p> <p>Rhymes – Butterfly butterfly, Baa baa black sheep, Hello Mr bunny rabbit.</p>
8	Plants fruits vegetables	<p>Explain to the child plants are living things.</p> <p>Show them the plant and name the main parts of the plants.</p> <p>Talk about importance of eating fruits and vegetables regularly.</p> <p>Show them fruits and vegetables and ask them their names.</p> <p>Ask the child about his/her favourite fruit/vegetable.</p> <p>Activity – Ask the child to bring small pieces of different fruits to the class. Help them to make fruit salad.</p> <p>Rhymes – a little seed for me to grow, ring –a-ring roses</p>
9	Seasons	<p>Speak about the three seasons – Summer, rainy and winter.</p> <p>Talk about the seasonal fruits. Also talk about the things we use in different seasons.</p> <p>Rhyme – Rain rain go away, I hear thunder</p>
10	Transport Road safety Traffic light Zebra crossing	<p>Talk about the different means of transport used on land, in air and in water.</p> <p>Speak about safety rules on road by following traffic rules, wearing helmets, seat belts, crossing roads.</p>
